

Enrolling at Beaumaris Secondary College Years 7-9

Enrolment at Beaumaris Secondary College is based on student's residence being within the schools designated neighbourhood boundary. Enrolment application may not be successful if the school does not accept that the address provided is the genuine permanent residence for the student.

- Recommend school tour prior to enrolment.
- Contact the College to arrange an enrolment interview with the Assistant Principal.

Things you will need to provide at the enrolment interview:

- Parents to bring two (2) documents confirming residence.
- Mid Semester or End of Year reports.
- Provide name and contact at previous school.

To assist Beaumaris Secondary College in assessing your child's eligibility for enrolment, please include in your enrolment application original or certified copies of:

1. Rental agreements or unconditional contracts of sale.

plus

A copy of two (2) of the following:

- electoral enrolment confirmation;
- council rates notices;
- other official documentation that demonstrates permanent residency at that address such as a driver's license or health care card.

Documents should show the same address and parents/carers name as recorded on the school enrolment application form.
